Documentation to be submitted

- a) Study plan containing all the courses of your chosen study program;
- b) Letter of recommendation issued by the person responsible of the International Office at the home institution;
- c) Transcript of records (transcript of grades, duly signed by the rectory of the home institution);
- d) Copy of the passport (all pages with stamps and entries);
- e) Photo 3x4 (attach to the application form).

After being accepted, the student should send the following documents to the International Affairs Office (NAI):

- a) Student visa;
- b) Statement of enrollment, issued by the home institution;
- c) The international student must obtain a national health plan covering medical/dental care, as soon as he/she arrives in Brazil.

Portuguese as a second language

1 - **Mobility of one semester** – The student will have specific Portuguese language classes and will study the undergraduation courses simultaneously;

2 – **Mobility of two semesters** - The student will have specific Portuguese language classes during the first and second semester and will study the undergraduation courses simultaneously.

We offer international students who come to UniEVANGÉLICA the opportunity to study Portuguese intensively and for free, so that when they complete the first semester they will have good command of the language, and by the end of the second semester, will have fluency.
